Third largest block of unfragmented forest land in NYS. Dense forest are interspersed with large wetland areas, including the headwaters of Deer River, Fish Creek, Mad River and Sandy Creek.

## Wildlife Connectivity Corridor

Partnership with the Nature Conservancy, Wildlife Conservation Society part of a regional effort to facilitate the movement of wide-ranging mammals between large blocks of protected forests across the Great Northern Forest stretching to Maine.

## Trenton Greenbelt/West Canada Creek

One of our earliest projects, Trenton Greenbelt combines public and private lands protected from development pressures by a variety of conservation easements. From the Trenton Falls to Route 28, most of the land along nearly two miles of West Canada Creek has been protected from development, forever.
